College Transfer Courses at Partnering Community Colleges

College Transfer courses are offered at reduced tuition (\$60 per course) at partnering community colleges. Textbooks for community college courses are included. Forms are available at www.ncmtec.org.

Consortium Sponsored Courses at Partnering Universities

Undergraduate level teacher education courses are offered at \$80 per course and graduate level teacher education courses are offered at \$200 per course.

- ◆ Mail-in registration is available each semester (dates & forms posted on www.ncmtec.org). This is the only opportunity to register for courses under this service.

Tuition Reimbursement

Requests may be made for reimbursement (up to \$350 per course with first priority for funding given to lateral entry teachers needing to clear their teacher license) for courses that are not Consortium sponsored at reduced tuition. Clients may receive reimbursement for two undergraduate and two graduate courses per year. Submission of the Tuition Reimbursement Pre-Approval Form, located on our website, is required by the due date. Priority will be given to courses sponsored by our partnering colleges and universities and accredited North Carolina Teacher Education Programs. Please note that tuition reimbursement is contingent upon the availability of funding, therefore, actual reimbursement may be less than, but no more than \$350 per three-hour course.

Praxis I and II Test Preparation

- ◆ Praxis I Seminars for Reading, Writing and Math are \$30 per seminar. Paraprofessional participants may request reimbursement of test fees once NCMTEC receives official scores from the Educational Testing Service.
- ◆ Praxis II Seminars in selected content areas are \$60 per seminar. Participants may request reimbursement for one half of the seminar fee once NCMTEC receives official scores from the Educational Testing Service.

Student Teaching Services

NCMTEC paraprofessionals may receive a monthly stipend of up to \$1100 while student teaching when required to take an unpaid leave of absence from the school system. Required tuition and fees of up to \$600 for each 3 hour course at an NCMTEC partnering university during the student teaching semester will also be paid. (Financial aid must be exhausted before NCMTEC funds are used.)
